Parade Rules and Behavior Expectations

In order for this year's Homecoming Parade to be a safe and successful even for all involved, the following guidelines apply to anyone participating in the Big Foot High School Homecoming Parade.

- All parade entry drivers **MUST** see Jenny Skemp in the district office at least *one week* prior to the parade. Bring your driver's license for a motor vehicle background check. If you are driving your personal vehicle, you must also bring proof of insurance. You will need to complete both the Alternate Vehicle Driver Information Request Form and the Student Transportation Consent Form.
- All parade entries and persons participating in the parade must be publicly and school appropriate. Swearing, nudity, drugs, or any references to these items will not be tolerated.
- All parade entries must be submitted to the Big Foot High School office by the deadline in order to gain a position in the parade.
- All persons participating in the parade must have notified the group leader of the entry and have permission to be on the float/vehicle, in the ensemble, etc.
- Throwing of candy, water balloons, balls or other items from any parade entry (vehicle or float) is prohibited.
- Stopping on the parade route is prohibited unless instructed to do so by the parade organizers or law enforcement.
- Use of water guns and silly string is prohibited.
- Candy, beads, balls, and other items may be distributed to audience members, but the distributors **MUST** be walking along the parade route.

Student Transportation Consent Form

If you plan to volunteer your time and vehicle to transport students for school district sponsored functions, you must agree to the following conditions:

- I am a consenting adult over the age of 21.
- I have a valid operator's license. I will provide a copy of my license to the District. I understand that the District reserves the right to review my Motor Vehicle Record (MVR).
- I have adequate insurance coverage on my vehicle. I will provide a copy of my insurance policy or a certificate of insurance to the District. *The following insurance policy limits are recommended: \$500,000 combined single limit (CSL) Liability, \$500,000/\$500,000 Bodily Injury, and \$100,000 Property Damage.*
- I will transport no more persons in my vehicle than the number of seat belts available. Each occupant of the vehicle will be required to wear a seat belt.
- I will inspect my vehicle prior to each trip to verify that it is in good working condition and that it contains a properly inflated spare tire and functional jack.

5. Any cancellation of my school bus endorsement of this state or another jurisdiction.
